

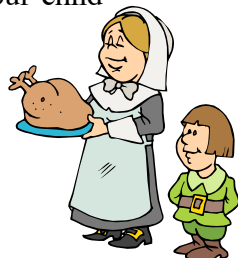

Classroom Observations
